<u>Motion to amend the Bylaws to state</u> Annual membership is **\$50** for individual membership, **\$100** for corporate member (up to 4), \$25 for additional corporate memberships, and \$5 for retired memberships. All Due structures shall be reviewed from time to time and may be altered by the Executive Committee with approval of the members.
