RE: Educational Opportunities Scholarship

Dear Members,

The Mid Central Water Works Association (MCWWA) develops and supports people, agencies, and organizations that plan, build, maintain, and improve our water systems. Working together, MCWWA and its membership contribute to a higher and sustainable quality of life.

Part of the Association's mission is to help communities understand the critical role that waterworks operations play in our lives. To fulfill this mission, the MCWWA has created an Educational Opportunity Scholarship program so that the members can further their education in the water works industry. Educational activities include seminars, webinars and classes. The goal of the scholarship is to introduce educational opportunities to waterworks officials who would not normally be able to register for this class due to funding constraints. This scholarship is only open to only public works officials and does not include contractors, engineers, sales representatives, etc.

Each scholarship winner will receive reimbursement for the cost of the seminars, webinars and classes for a maximum of \$200, whichever is less. All other cost greater than \$200 will be the responsibility of the applicant.

Awards Available

- Total Budget \$400
- Maximum Stipend Awarded \$200
- Additional scholarships may be awarded if funding and applicants are available

Eligibility

- Applicant must be a member of the Mid Central Water Works Association (MCWWA).
- Applicant must be employed by public water systems. Contractors, engineers, sales representatives, etc., are not eligible for the scholarship.
- Applicants' employer must not be offering reimbursement for such classes.
- Previous winners of Educational Opportunities Scholarships are not eligible to re-apply for this scholarship.

Judging Criteria

• Applicants will be chosen by a "first come/first serve" basis.

Submittals

- To be considered for a scholarship, the following must be completed and submitted:
 - The General Information Form
 - Sign and date the application. Electronic signatures for applications submitted by e-mail are acceptable.
